

Fast Facts: Admission to US Colleges

Start Here

- Set up free 10-minutes consultation with NAVA staff to find out if you even qualify
- **4** Students must be 18 years or older to qualify
- Students must have completed at least F4/S4 or high school
- ↓ Students can be accepted in many US college with just F4/S4
- **4** Student must have at least 2.0 GPA
- ↓ If you qualify, fill out NAVA Student Interest Form
- Pay NAVA consultation cost
- Work with NAVA staff to start the college application process mostly done online
- ♣ Pay college application fees (cost between \$50 to \$100)
- **Work with NAVA to prepare financial statements**
- 4 Once college accepts your financial statements, you are good to go
- Work with NAVA to get your I-20 to help prepare for US visa
- Complete US Immigration Form I-901 (cost \$350 paid to US government) after that is done,
- **Work with NAVA to fill out Visa application**
- **4** Work with NAVA to prepare for visa interview in your home country

Most US colleges accept applications anytime, but there are deadlines for various semesters.

FAQ

- 1. Who pays for a student Visa? A: The parent/student is responsible for visa application.
- 2. Why should I pay for Form I-901? A: It is required by the US government without it you will not be able to set up visa interview.
- 3. How long does it take me to get admitted into college if I have all the necessary documents? **A**: time varies but it is possible to get it in as short as one month.
- 4. Do I have to pay for the I-20? A: No, it is part of the application fee.
